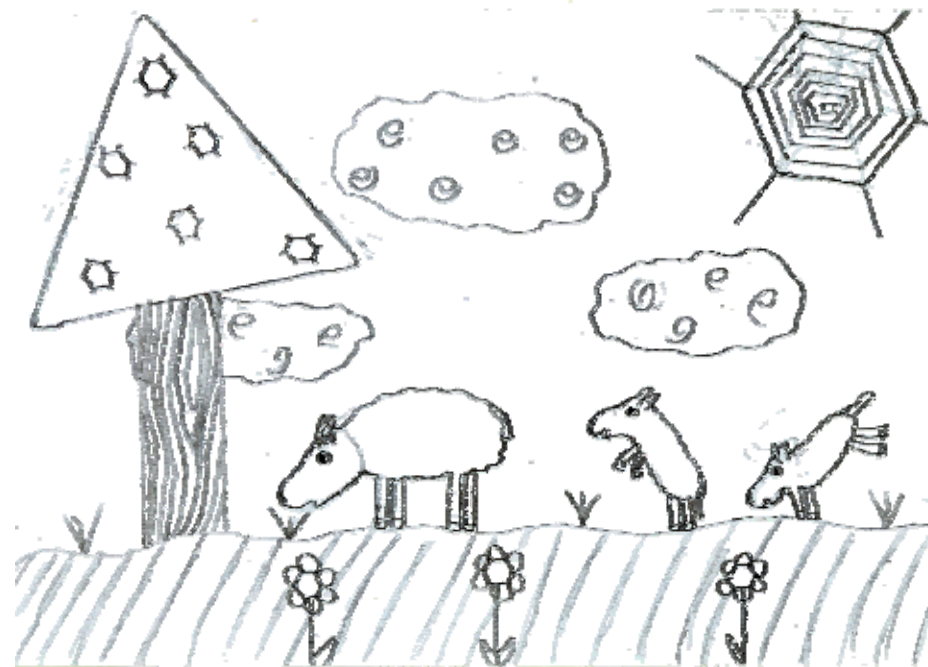

A MESSAGE FROM REVEREND ALISON HAMPTON

Have you ever felt that your life is good and all is well? Suddenly things change. You are coping very well at one level, but deep inside there is a feeling of unfulfilment – the sparkle has gone. You feel, as one writer puts it, “soul-napped”. All you can do is travel on, waiting for something to happen. St Luke tells a story about two travellers, going to Emmaus, who feel just like that. They're disappointed with life. The death of Jesus and the disappearance of his body had dashed all their hope. They had expected change and it hadn't happened. They wanted to go about their business as usual but it was impossible because they were pre-occupied with past events in Jerusalem.

There is little information about the travellers, except one is called Cleopas and that at the beginning of the story they are downcast, perhaps soul-napped, but by the end, they felt that their hearts, their inner souls, had burned within them. On that journey Jesus is unrecognised. He joins the conversation and the travellers attempt to share and make sense of their story. It's a sad one, almost without hope – words cannot be found to describe the feeling of loss. The desolation is obvious from the conversation: “We hoped that he would be the one who would redeem Israel”, “The woman couldn't find his body”.

Jesus speaks of the scriptures but his words alone are not enough to disclose his identity. We have to ask, had these people ever recognised Jesus as the Messiah? The idea that they had left Jerusalem suggests that they were prepared to leave the journey of faith and forget all association with Jesus, now that he had been removed from their sight. Turning away from difficulty is a very human response to disappointment. Here were two people who had hoped for so much. Perhaps they had got it wrong? Perhaps Jesus wasn't all they had believed him to be? Despite their downcast state, when they arrived at the village, the late hour of their arrival provided them with an opportunity to offer hospitality. Through their concern to provide for the stranger, the sadness is turned to joy because, as Jesus broke bread, gave thanks and gave it to them, their eyes were opened and they finally recognised him.

Despite the signs, is it easy to spot God – to hear his word, feel his breath, see those signs? I am sure that the answer is a unanimous “no”! As we travel through life, it becomes difficult to catch any glimpse of faith – let alone a burning heart.

We know so little about those travellers except that their hearts were slow and burning. Our encounters with Christ are mostly like that, enigmatic, fleeting, mere glimpses. Then we can ask the same question “Did our hearts burn within us?”

The road to Emmaus is that most travelled. What should we do when we feel “soul-napped”? The way of faith is about having a conviction of something understood. What defines us on our journey to Emmaus is this hope. What defines the travellers and us is that burning heart, that feeling that there is something else. The story of that journey and all that befell the travellers shows us that Christ is with us, but not always recognised. We need to look for the signs. That burning serves to rekindle the hope we have in our salvation.

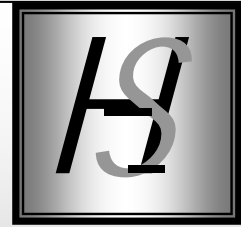

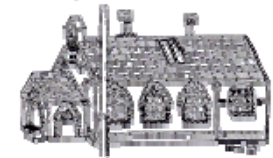

 For almost a year the governors and staff at Arnesby and Mowsley have been preparing all the paperwork required for yet another inspection! This time we were being assessed for our compliance with standards regarding how we manage our finances - the Financial Management Standards in Schools, (FMSiS), an audit process which includes leadership and governance, people management, policies, resource management and financial procedures. The day of the inspection was during the disruption of snow early in February and special arrangements had to be made to open the school for the Inspector, who had travelled from London. We had arranged for the schools to be inspected on the same day, as a Federation (with a reduction in cost), as so much of the detail was similar.

I am pleased to say that we have received a letter telling us that both Arnesby and Mowsley schools have "successfully achieved the standards". The phrase does not reflect the huge amount of time spent on project meetings, devising new policies, and collating and presenting information; the requirements being the same for all schools, regardless of the size of the school and its budget. The DCSF will shortly provide us with certification and a logo to use on our stationery.

I would like to congratulate all the staff at both schools and the governors, particularly the Finance Committee, the Chair Beryl Cane, and Jo Turner (Mowsley Secretary) co-opted as project leader, for their hard work and dedication. Having met the standards, now there is the challenge of maintaining and updating all the information so that FMSiS becomes a continuous development process, ready to be assessed again in three years!

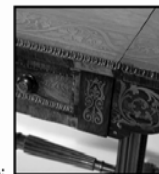
