



Tracing the Loseby Family in Arnesby: John Loseby left "by will dated 1668; to the use of the Town of Arnesby twenty pounds: also to the poor of this Parish seventy pounds." This is inscribed on a memorial in St Peter's Church tower. A stained glass window was erected in the church by the Trustees, the recipients of his charity and others in 1874. Roslyn & Graeme Allan visited Arnesby whilst on a brief visit from Australia to trace Loseby family connections in Leicestershire. One of Roslyn's Loseby relatives left for Australia in the first half of the 19th century. Roslyn & Graeme are pictured below next to the memorial.



The Loseby Trust administers the land now used as allotments and the new wood and wild-life area in Arnesby.




