What is sure in life?

I started to think about my first article for the Hexagon magazine during the third cricket test between England and Australia.



It's a Saturday morning and the game has been halted due to rain, not really a surprise this summer! I wonder if England, one game in the lead, will win the Ashes. Of course nothing is certain in life. Three years ago I would never have envisaged a banking crisis, a downturn in the economy, swine flu and moving home to be surrounded by boxes containing some valuables, many non valuables and much rubbish! Can we be sure of anything?

Quentin Crisp's view was that 'life was a funny thing that occurred on the way to the grave!' I wonder what you hold onto? What gives you satisfaction? Nineteen years ago someone told me about the life of a man called Jesus. Different events of his life were recorded in the Gospels and shattered my many pre-conceptions about Christianity. I wondered why I had never turned to this 'book of life' before, full of insight, wisdom and spirituality. Jesus reveals a God who is sure, trustworthy, challenging and real; someone to hold onto, someone who satisfies. Incredibly, we find that Jesus is God's son, breaking into our world and experiencing what we experience. He offers a free gift, 'I am the bread of life, whoever comes to me will never be hungry, whoever believes in me will never be thirsty' (John 6:35). It can be a courageous step to ask God, through Jesus, to be part of our lives, but then that is why the Church is here, to help us through those steps.

England has lost the fourth test as I finish this article and I wonder if we can regain the Ashes. By the time this article is published I could be celebrating a victory or be disappointed, but I do know that the 'bread of life' is certain and will not diminish.

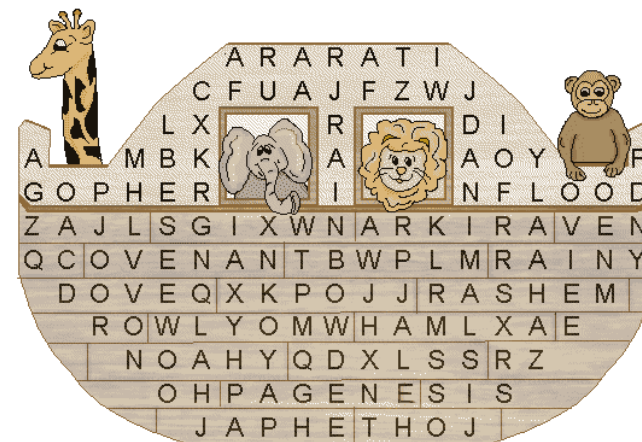
