Hopefully you found the time to drop her a message, if you have yet been unable to, Zandra is keen to know your thoughts please. As a reminder.... Below are the options Zandra has requested feedback on:

Diary

- 1. Turn back to a grassed verge?
- 2. Plant a more formal bed with some shrubs and fill it with flowering pollinator plants to add colour structure. It would be rich pickings for our wildlife.

We have been awarded a small environmental grant to further develop, long term, self-sustaining pockets of flora rich areas throughout the village. Our aim is that they become havens, rich in biodiversity for our local wildlife. These sites should become steppingstones for our pollinators and other wildlife along the emerging wildlife corridor throughout Leicestershire.




Welcome Newbies


