
# **Doggie Doings....**

### **Notice from Harborough District Council**

The current three-year Public Space Protection Orders (PSPO) for Alcohol Control and Dog Controls will shortly be ending, we are therefore looking to extend these orders for a further three years. The current Dog Control PSPO covers the whole District. It created three offences which covers:

- · Failing to remove dog faeces
- · Failing to put a dog on a lead after a request by an authorised officer
- · Failing to have an appropriate means to pick up dog faeces
- These can be enforced by authorised officers at Harborough District Council.
